As we head towards the festive season we would like to celebrate the past year with you. We invite you to Christmas drinks and to say thankyou on December 9th. Find more details [below](#).

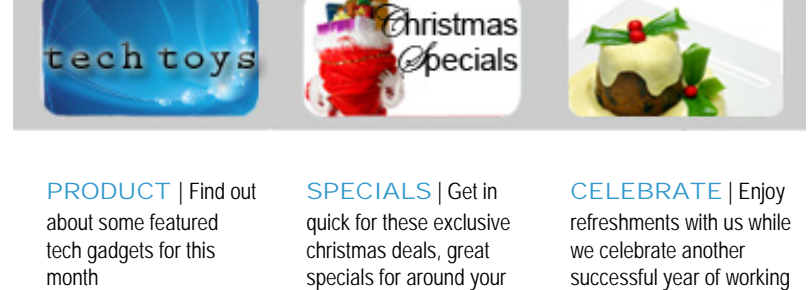
